The B.Ed. Association hosted a webinar to commemorate National Education Day on Tuesday, January 18th, 2022. The programme was organised under the guidance of Mrs. Shanthi Subbiah, Head of Department of Education, Dr. Rupa Sarkar, Event Co-Ordinator, Ms. Priya Ann Joseph, Event Facilitator, Ms. Priyanka V, Association In-Charge. Riya Suresh and Sheetal Singh of Semester VI B.Sc.B.Ed. from the B.Ed. Association were in-charge of creative and technical aspects of the event. The guest speakers were Dr. C R Chandrashekar, Former Professor of Psychiatry and Deputy Medical Superintendent, NIMHANS, Bengaluru, and Dr. Anima Chowdhary, a Certified Career Counsellor. Dr. Rupa Sarkar and Mehar Fathima (VI B.Sc. B.Ed. CBZ), the event host, delivered the welcome speech.


Dr. C R Chandrashekar gave a talk on "Adolescence, Tranquillity, and Calmness" in the first session. Dr. Chandrashekar enlightened on a person's thinking power and memory retention and further spoke about the issues of adolescence and how to overcome them. He went on to say that time management, organisation skills, job satisfaction, and mental wellness are vital elements. At 10.30 AM., the session ended, followed by a Q&A session with the guest speaker.

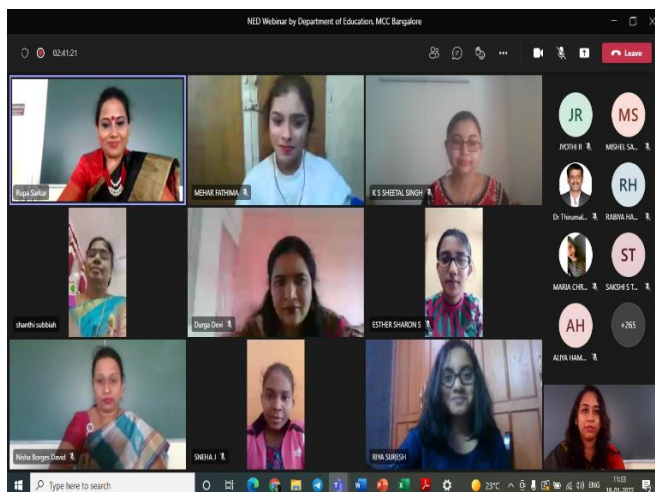
