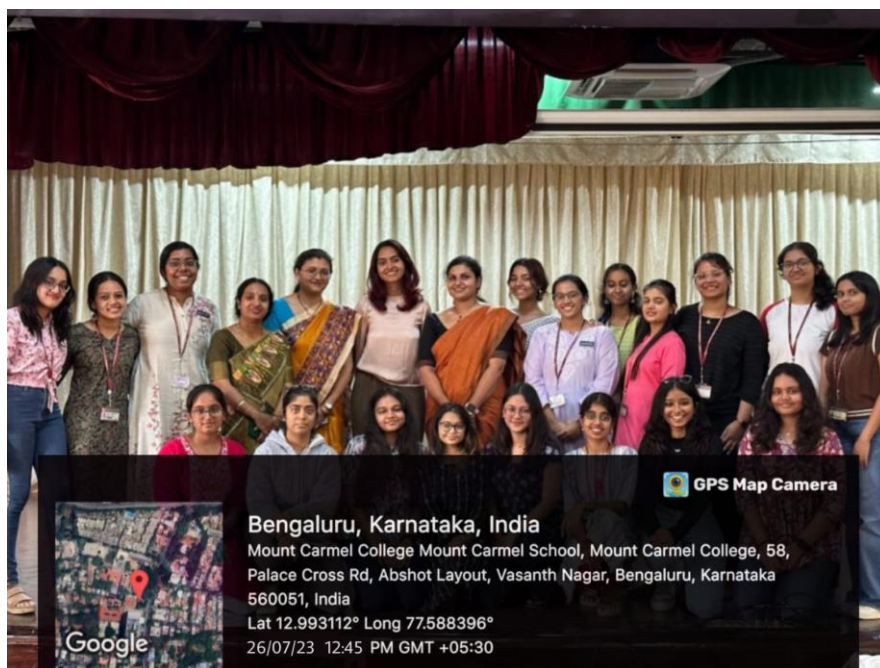
Title of the Activity: **" Navigating Student Life - College and Beyond"**
