


India-Maldives Diplomatic Fallout and the China Factor

7 March 2024

An interactive and engaging session was held on the recent developments on the India-Maldives diplomatic relationship by Mr. PM Heblikar, who retired as Special Secretary, Government of India.


Mr. Heblikar discussed the background and the history of India's relationship with Maldives and segued into the recent fall-out and its contributing factors.




He also discussed the role of China and its diplomatic and geo-political strategies and their effect on this now tenuous relationship.
