REPORT ON TALK ON VIDHYAGAMA

Ms Parvathamma, a head master of government school, Gowribidanur, Bangalore rural district, gave a talk to Educational Psychology students on the Vidhyagama project undertaken by Karnataka Education dept during Covid lockdown. She spoke about how in the absence of school during covid, the government school teachers conducted classes for children in open playgrounds, temple premises and other places and imparted education. The entire scheme was carried out smoothly for few months till some teachers contracted covid. But thanks to the work of these teachers, students who could not access online education greatly benefited from the teachers efforts.

Vidhyagama was brought to a halt for sometime when covid infections increased rapidly, but resumed after wards till offline classes started. All the subjects were taught in this manner.
