An interactive and engaging session titled ‘Women, Work and Wages in India;

“Claudia Goldin and Us” was conducted by ARTHA Association with Dr. Neethi.

Dr. Neethi is a senior researcher at Indian Institute for Human Settlements (IIHS).

Dr. Neethi’s discussed topics ranging from globalisation and labour, with a focus on labour informality, analysing diverse informal sectors and their associated workers to labour geography.

She highlighted the need for moving away from economic orthodoxy and borrowing from sociological, anthropological, and ethnographic approaches.
